

Servicing the burgeoning community of Ramat Bait Shemesh , Yeshiva Zichron Dovid/ Nachlas Yisroel Yitzchok is a unique educational complex with an exciting mission. As the Anglo community in Eretz Yisroel grows in leaps and bounds, the existing educational structure is not sufficient to address the various needs of English speaking Olim.

Yeshiva Zichron Dovid's flagship high school is designed to address this need. They offer a mainstream Chareidi Yeshiva Ketana (high school), with Rabbeim who are trained to offer the extra support and flexibility required for students who have made the difficult cultural transition from the North American system to the Israeli system. Yeshiva Zichron Dovid features small classes with an emphasis on the Rebbe-Talmid relationship. This enables the Rebbe to become attuned to the complete needs of each individual student – educationally, emotionally, and socially. Their goal is to be mechanach the entire child, so as to produce graduates who enjoy their learning, and are committed to a Yiddishkeit that is vibrant, exciting and “geshmak”, in whatever environment they find themselves. The curriculum is founded in the tradition of Harav Henschel Leibowitz, tz”l and the Slabodka path, with an intense, in depth learning program, as well as a focus on Mussar and character development. They strive to instill in their students a true sense of Ahavas Yisroel and responsibility to the greater Jewish community, as well as a love for Eretz Yisroel. They offer their students a sophisticated program of involved learning, as well as offering support and preparation for students wishing to pursue higher secular learning.

In addition to the Yeshiva Ketana, they have numerous programs developed to support this target community. Yeshiva Zichron Dovid offers parental education to help families integrate into the system. They offer extracurricular programs and activities for their students, including trips, chess projects, and sports. They sponsor a separate alternative high school program for boys who are unable to manage the long, intense program of a mainstream Chareidi Yeshiva. Finally they are proud of their Yeshiva Gedolah (Bais Medrash) program, servicing both local students as well as students from overseas.

Yeshiva Zichron Dovid is in the midst of building a beautiful new facility in the heart of Ramat Bait Shemesh A, which will enable them to expand and enhance their critical programs. Construction is underway, and a Chanukas Habayis is being planned for later on this year. Your support will help this important Mosad continue its vital work.
